Albert-George Schram will conduct this exciting performance when the circus meets the symphony. Including two members of the famous Wallenda circus family, Cirque Musica features nine guest performers demonstrating impressive circus acts set to live symphonic favorites, such as “Flight of the Bumblebee” from *Tale of the Tsar Saltan*, John Williams’s beloved themes to *Star Wars* and *Superman*, and Aaron Copland’s “Hoe-Down” from *Rodeo*.

The concert will also include selections from original music composer Marcelo Zarvos, who has written for films such *The Good Shepherd*, *Hollywoodland*, *Kissing Jessica Stein*, as well as the Academy Award-nominated short film, *A Soccer Story*.
