**MAY 3 & 4 SYMPHONIC CINEMA
AN EVENING OF BRITISH AND AMERICAN MOVIE MUSIC**

April 22, 2013 | CHARLOTTE, NC – Artistically mirroring his own journey from the UK to the US, Charlotte Symphony Music Director Christopher Warren-Green will lead the Orchestra on a musical mission with British secret service agent 007 and conduct a train to Hogwarts before flying with American film favorites Batman and E.T. at Symphonic Cinema.

Opening with the James Bond Suite, the entire first half of Symphonic Cinema will feature selections with strong British connections. After intermission, the program will begin like a night at the Oscars as the Symphony plays “Hooray for Hollywood,” a fitting intro to popular American movie music.

In addition to Bond, Batman, and E.T., other highlights include the main title from the British epic film *Lawrence of Arabia*, “Smile” from Charlie Chaplin’s *Modern Times*, *The Godfather* “Love Theme,” and

Pirates of the Caribbean. And of course, “no movie-music concert today would be complete without *Harry Potter*, especially since this is a night for the whole family,” said Warren-Green.

The Charlotte Symphony will perform Symphonic Cinema at 8 p.m. on Friday, May 3 and Saturday, May 4 at the Knight Theater. Tickets start at \$34.50 and can be purchased at charlottesymphony.org or by calling 704-972-2000.

Symphonic Cinema serves as the Charlotte Symphony's 2012-2013 Pops Series finale.
