LANG LANG TICKETS ON SALE JUNE 12

June 6, 2017 | CHARLOTTE, NC – In his debut appearance in Charlotte, world-renowned pianist [Lang Lang](#) opens the Charlotte Symphony’s exciting 2017-18 season with a one-night-only performance of Beethoven’s Emperor Concerto on Tuesday, September 12 at 7:30 p.m. at Belk Theater at Blumenthal Performing Arts Center.

Music Director Christopher Warren-Green will conduct the globally recognized superstar, whom *The New York Times* has called “the hottest artist on the classical music planet.”

Known for his extraordinary skill and creative collaborations, Lang Lang has teamed up with artists from Metallica and Pharrell Williams to Herbie Hancock. He has performed on the world’s top stages, including performances at the Grammy Awards and the Vatican.

“Bringing Lang Lang to Charlotte is very exciting,” says Maestro Warren-Green. “Perhaps no other artist of today has the keen ability to see across the musical genre boundaries and create new art. This will be a once-in-a-lifetime musical experience and we are thrilled to bring him to the Queen City.”
