CHARLOTTE SYMPHONY ANNOUNCES REVISED CONCERT SCHEDULE DUE TO MECKLENBURG COUNTY'S NEW COVID-19 DIRECTIVE

Previously Announced Virtual Concerts Have Been Rescheduled PLUS: Free Concert Added for Series Subscribers

In light of new coronavirus health guidelines from the Mecklenburg County Public Health Director, and in compliance with Blumenthal Performing Arts Center, the Charlotte Symphony will suspend all rehearsals, recordings, and live virtual concerts through February 2, 2021.

All four previously announced virtual concerts — Mozart Night Music, Holst + Elgar, Mozart + Wirén, and Beethoven Symphony No. 1 — have been rescheduled for February 6–April 24, 2021. Visit www.charlottesymphony.org/classical for a full schedule.

Classical Series subscribers will also receive free access to a bonus concert, previously recorded at Symphony Park and featuring the CSO's brass and wind sections led by Resident Conductor Christopher James Lees.
